1. That your Petitioner was on the 14th day of March 1916
at the Register Office in the district of St. Pancras
in the said County of London lawfully married to Helene
Zalin then Helene Cox Spinster.
2. That after his said marriage your Petitioner lived and
cohabited with his said wife at No. 140 Hampstead Road
in the said County of London and elsewhere and that there
is living issue of their said marriage one child namely
Abdul Almos Athanasius Wladimer Fedor Tristram Zalin
born on the 17th day of July 1916.
3. That your Petitioner resides at 13 Parliament Hill
Hampstead in the County of London is a Teacher and Composer
of Music and is domiciled in England.
4. That the said Helene Zalin resides at 28 Burgess Road
East Ham in the said County of London and is domiciled
in England.
5. That there have been no previous proceedings in reference
to the said marriage in the Divorce Division of the High
Court of Justice by or on behalf of either party to the
said marriage.

6. That the said Helene Zalin has frequently committed adultery with Alexis Gellman.
7. That between the 9th day of December 1917 and the 31st day of January 1918 at 33 Stanley Gardens Hampstead in the County of London the said Helene Zalin committed adultery with the said Alexis Gellman.
8. That your Petitioner claims from the said Alexis Gellman as damages in respect of such adultery the sum of £250:0:0d or such sum as may be assessed by a Jury.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays:-

1. That his said marriage may be dissolved.
2. That he may have the custody of the said child of the marriage.
3. That your Lordship will be pleased to ascertain by the verdict of a jury the amount of damages to be paid by the Co Respondent and to direct how such damages shall be applied.
4. That he may have such other relief as may be just.
